- Your driving licence or passport.
- Your marriage certificate (if applicable).
- Any correspondence that you have had with your partner or their solicitors.
- Any court papers or orders you have received.
- A list of any relevant questions that you would like us to answer.
- Full names, addresses and dates of birth for you, your partner and any dependent children.
- If finances are involved a schedule setting out your assets and income and those of your partner (if known).
- Any valuations or appraisals of assets you have obtained.
